Health Right, Inc. is a Managed Care Organization (MCO) duly licensed in the District of Columbia and is owned by two Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC); Unity Health Care and Columbia Road Health Services. Health Right, Inc. provides quality health care, disease prevention, health promotion, and case management services for the Medicaid and the Alliance populations. Their mission is to provide the best comprehensive and quality patient care in a culturally sensitive manner.

Health Right's comprehensive health benefits include, primary care visits, specialists' visits, inpatient hospitalizations, prescription benefits, and dental services as well as coordinated outreach and health education activities. Due to its affiliation with the Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), Health Right emphasizes continuity of care for members who lose their Medicaid eligibility; enrollees are still able to receive care at the Federally Qualified Health Center.

Health Right's model focuses on primary care services for all of its members across their life span; a strong emphasis is placed on preventive services and health promotion. More than 70% of HRI's Medicaid members are children under the age of 21 years. Hence, HRI places particular priority on those children eligible for the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT) and has developed an extensive outreach and case management program to target these individuals. However, our programs serve members of all ages and emphasize preventive care, outreach, and health education. Our comprehensive benefits cover primary and specialty care, hospitalization, prescriptions, dental and vision services, and transportation.

As of June 1, 2006, Health Right's services expanded to provide managed care for Alliance members: low-income DC residents who don't qualify for Medicaid. Founded in 2002 by the DC government, Alliance provides free health insurance for uninsured residents with income equal to or below 200 percent of the federal poverty level.

Health Right's comprehensive provider network includes providers who have traditionally provided services to the underserved community. Through this network, Health Right, Inc. has primary care health centers located within every ward in the District of Columbia.
